HIGHER EDUCATION LAPTOP/DESKTOP PROGRAM APPLICATION

The Gun Lake Tribe Education Department will provide reimbursement up to \$1000 for the purchase of a laptop or desktop computer to eligible Gun Lake Tribe Higher Education Students enrolled in college or technical school.

Eligibility:

- Be a Citizen of the Gun Lake Tribe.
- Currently enrolled in a degree or certification program at an accredited college/university or technical school as evidenced by a current course schedule.
- Be in good standing with the Gun Lake Tribe Education Department (abiding by all requirements for scholarships awarded).
- Have a minimum overall GPA of 2.0 (or equivalent) for undergraduate students. Graduate students must have a
 minimum overall GPA of 3.0 (or equivalent). OR be a newly enrolled student who has never accessed the Higher
 Education and Technical Career Scholarship.
- Not have accessed this program while enrolled in a degree or certification program within the last three years.

Applicants must submit the following:

- A completed Higher Education Laptop Program application.
- Proof of purchase (Receipt).
- Current class schedule from institution.
- Copy current unofficial transcript as proof of good standing and GPA requirement (previously enrolled Highter Education and Technical Career scholarship recipients only)

Note:

- This program may be accessed once every three years.
- Citizens are responsible for safe keeping, maintenance, and required updates for the Laptop or Desktop. Tribe will
 not replace lost, stolen, or damaged computers.
- Checks are mailed to the current address on file with Tribal Member Benefits
- Applicants receiving Higher Education Laptops program funds cannot submit requests for payment or reimbursement under any other Tribal program or service if a different program has already been accessed for the same expense and duplication of benefits will exceed the amount of the service or good. The Department has the right to decline any submission when it comes to the Department's attention that the applicant has already submitted a request for reimbursement under another tribal program or has already received a reimbursement for the same expense from the Higher Education Laptops program funds. The Department may also, depending on the circumstances, request an applicant to return their reimbursement to the Tribe if it later discovers that the applicant used another source of funds in addition to the Higher Education Laptop Program funds.
